Sea Island Hunger Awareness Foundation, which Shirley established in 2014, serves as a large umbrella for numerous and varied social services for the disadvantaged. Weekly food deliveries, crock-pot classes, and new, free wells for those without clean water are just a few of the many services rendered.

Prior to 2014 and the founding of SIHAF, Shirley enjoyed a peaceful retirement from a teaching career. Since then, it's become her "day-in and day-out" search for better ways to help our local underprivileged neighbors, and to recruit more inspired women to help.

Our entire barrier island community is fortunate to have Shirley as one of our own, and whether she wins that trip to New York City or not, she's our number one pick for a most remarkable woman.
